

PRESS REPORT

Louis Lynch Champs Barbados

Weekend 24th – 25th February 2007

At the Louis Lynch championship in Barbados our athletes walked away with five gold and five silver medals.

The results were as follows:

Purnel Esprit finished 2nd in the U-17 boys javelin with a throw of 50.52 meters he later went on to tie for 2nd place in the high jump with a height of 1.75meters.

Julius Henry made us proud by securing Dominica first ever regional medal in the hurdles event. He placed 2nd in the U-17 boys 100m hurdles in a time of 14.66 seconds.

Enzinga Darroux won silver in the U-17 girls' high jump in a height of 1.55m.

Nabi Wallace emerged winner of the senior men long jump with a distance of 6.84 meters.

While we had Brendan Williams securing silver in the senior men high jump after clearing a height of 2.05 meters.

Dillon Simon did a double as he won the U-17 boys shot put with a distance of 13.81meters and the discus with a distance of 38.57 meters.

However it was Narelle Magloire who was the happiest of the lot as she won gold in the U-17 girls' discus with a qualifying throw for the Carifta games of 32.64meters. She later went on to win gold in the shot put with a throw of 9.19 meters.
